



ABLE ENGINEER COVID-19 SAFETY TRAINING

In order to prepare a facility for increased occupancy after a period of inactivity or reduced activity, the Able Services staff will be provided with:

- PPE as recommended by our national safety department following CDC and OSHA guidelines
- Training on the proper use and disposal of PPE
- Training on infection prevention and control measures
- Cross training to ensure critical building functions are maintained in an emergency
- Instruction to staff to stay at home if they are feeling sick

Each employee takes ownership in Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and will perform tasks only when properly trained and have the proper PPE. Engineering staff will also follow applicable safety practices, existing regulatory requirements, policies, procedures and risk assessments.

Able Services team members pride themselves in maintaining a safe and compliant work environment.
